What cookies MaintlyQR uses, why we use them, and how to manage them.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device by websites you visit. They enable a website to recognise your browser, maintain your session, and remember certain preferences.

2. Cookies We Use

MaintlyQR uses only essential / functional cookies. These are strictly required for the Platform to operate. They do not track you for advertising or marketing purposes.

Specifically:

- Session authentication cookies — issued by Supabase to keep you logged in during your session
- CSRF protection tokens — prevent cross-site request forgery attacks
- User preference cookies — remember basic UI preferences such as language or theme

3. Cookies We Do Not Use

MaintlyQR does not use:

- Advertising or targeting cookies
- Third-party tracking pixels (Facebook Pixel, Google Ads, etc.)
- Social media tracking cookies
- Third-party analytics cookies (e.g. Google Analytics)

We may conduct internal analytics using aggregated server-side data only, which does not involve placing cookies on your device.

4. Cookie Lifetime

Session cookies: automatically deleted when you close your browser or log out.

Persistent cookies (where used): expire after a maximum of 30 days or when you log out, whichever is sooner.

5. Managing Cookies

You can control and delete cookies through your browser settings. Most modern browsers allow you to view, block, or delete cookies at any time.

Disabling essential cookies will prevent you from logging in and using core Platform features. Public QR pages — which require no login — will continue to function without cookies.

6. Changes to This Policy

If we introduce new cookie types, we will update this Policy and notify registered users before the change takes effect.
