

API Terms of Use

Document 09 of 10 • MaintlyQR Legal Package v1.1

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The terms governing programmatic access to the MaintlyQR Platform.

1. About the MaintlyQR API

MaintlyQR may offer an Application Programming Interface ("API") enabling developers, businesses, and partners to programmatically access and interact with Platform data and functionality.

These API Terms supplement the Terms of Service (Document 1). In the event of conflict, these API Terms prevail with respect to API use.

The MaintlyQR API is currently in development. These terms establish the governance framework that will apply when API access becomes available.

2. API Access and Authentication

API access requires: (a) a registered MaintlyQR account in good standing; and (b) a valid API key issued by MaintlyQR.

API keys are issued at MaintlyQR's sole discretion. We may decline, restrict, or revoke API access at any time.

You are responsible for keeping your API key confidential. Do not embed keys in client-side code, public repositories, or any publicly accessible location. Report a compromised key to us immediately.

3. Permitted API Use

Subject to these terms, you may use the API to:

- Access and display data from your own assets and Maintenance Ledgers
- Submit maintenance records to assets you manage
- Build internal tools or integrations for your own business operations
- Build third-party applications that have been approved in writing by MaintlyQR

4. Prohibited API Use

You may not use the API to:

- Access or aggregate data belonging to other users without their consent
- Build competing products that replicate MaintlyQR's core functionality
- Sell or resell API access to third parties
- Exceed rate limits or circumvent API throttling mechanisms
- Submit false or fraudulent maintenance records at scale
- Introduce malicious code through API calls

- Degrade Platform performance for other users

5. Rate Limits

MaintlyQR enforces rate limits to ensure fair access and Platform stability. Specific limits will be published in the API documentation at launch.

Exceeding rate limits may result in temporary suspension. Persistent violations may result in permanent revocation of API access.

6. Attribution

Applications that display MaintlyQR data must include a visible attribution statement, such as: 'Powered by MaintlyQR' or 'Maintenance data provided by MaintlyQR'. Exact format requirements will be in the API documentation.

7. Data Rights

Data accessed through the API is subject to the same ownership and licence terms as data accessed through the Platform. You may not: (a) claim ownership of MaintlyQR data; (b) redistribute raw API data to third parties without authorisation; or (c) use API data to train AI models without MaintlyQR's written consent.

8. API Pricing and Plans

MaintlyQR currently offers API access at no charge during the early access phase. We reserve the right to introduce paid API plans, tiered access levels, and usage-based quotas at any time.

API users will receive at least 30 days' advance notice of any pricing changes affecting their existing access tier. Continued use of the API after a pricing change takes effect constitutes acceptance of the new terms.

9. Service Level and Availability

MaintlyQR does not guarantee API uptime, availability, or response times. The API may be modified, deprecated, or discontinued at any time. We will provide reasonable advance notice of breaking changes.

10. Termination of API Access

MaintlyQR may terminate your API access at any time for violation of these terms, the Terms of Service, or the Acceptable Use Policy. Upon termination, all associated API keys are immediately invalidated.
